Please note the following restrictions for the Howard University exam in December due to a travel ban imposed by the District of Columba. All candidates registering for this exam must comply with the following instructions. **No exceptions will be made.**

1. If you are coming from a state listed on the travel ban you will need to comply with the following instructions:

The quarantine policy requires candidates to take two COVID-19 Tests. The first must be submitted via email and be taken 3-5 days before their arrival to Washington D.C. Once in the area, each candidate must take and email one more negative COVID-19 test within 3-5 days of arriving. The second test must be submitted by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 1st</u>, <u>2020</u>. There will be no exceptions to this policy and those who are unable to adhere to these requirements will not be allowed to take the exam. Please email results to <u>jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu</u>.

2. If you are not coming from a state listed on the travel ban you will still need to comply with the following instructions:

All candidates must send in a negative COVID-19 test taken 5-7 days prior to your exam date. Please email results to jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu.
