

Please note the following restrictions for the Howard University exam in December due to a travel ban imposed by the District of Columbia. All candidates registering for this exam must comply with the following instructions. **No exceptions will be made.**

1. **If you are coming from a state listed on the travel ban you will need to comply with the following instructions:**

The quarantine policy requires candidates to take two COVID-19 Tests. The first must be submitted via email and be taken 3-5 days before their arrival to Washington D.C. Once in the area, each candidate must take and email one more negative COVID-19 test within 3-5 days of arriving. The second test must be submitted by Tuesday, December 1st, 2020. There will be no exceptions to this policy and those who are unable to adhere to these requirements will not be allowed to take the exam. Please email results to jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu.

2. **If you are not coming from a state listed on the travel ban you will still need to comply with the following instructions:**

All candidates must send in a negative COVID-19 test taken 5-7 days prior to your exam date. Please email results to jezelle.sonnier@howard.edu.
