Facility Use Fee: \$130.00

The facility use fee includes: Use of facility, instruments (handpieces, contra-angles, ultrasonics [Cavitrons and Cavitron Jet] and all supplies. Payment can be made a week prior to exam by calling 412-648-3100, ask for registration and pay for the clinic usage fee with a credit card.

<u>NOTE:</u> Candidates will be required to leave their <u>current</u> driver's license card and a credit card at the instrument dispensary as a "security deposit" when picking up their instruments. When all instruments are returned and accounted for at the end of each day/session, the candidate's driver's license card and credit card will be returned.

Exam Patients

It is the responsibility of the candidate to provide their own patients. The School is not responsible for providing patients.

Supplies

Low speed handpiece and dental hygiene instruments **ARE PROVIDED** by the School. Cavitrons[®] and/or Cavijets[®] and universal tips **ARE** also provided as well as all disposable supplies, disinfectant materials, and local anesthetic agents for administration of local anesthesia should it be required. **Oragix[®] is not provided - candidates must supply their own.**

**Anyone who brings their own instruments and does not use the instrument cassette provided by the school, must transport their contaminated instruments in a container that meets OSHA guidelines. The contaminated instruments must be placed in a puncture resistant leak-proof on sides and bottom of the container, labeled "biohazard".

Additional points:

- Chair Assignment will be posted in the dental hygiene clinical area (B- level).
- Orientation will take place in Salk Hall the day of the examination. Room number will be posted.
