### **Important ADEX – Manikin Exam Information**

#### **NHTI Travel Guidance During COVID-19 Pandemic**

Due to travel policies established at NHTI, Concord's Community College, only candidates who reside in the New England states (New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut, or Rhode Island) will be permitted on campus for this MTCE Exam.

Please be advised that all candidates and examiners from the New England states will be screened at the door and have their temperature checked. You must pass screening criteria in order to enter the building and take the exam.

NHTI, due to risk factors, is not accepting NH residents or out-of-state visitors who have traveled internationally, on a cruise ship or to/from areas of the United States outside of New England (New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut, or Rhode Island) within the fourteen (14) days prior to the examination.

#### **Pre-Exam Screening Information**

Upon arrival to the NHTI, Concord's Community College campus, you will need to report to Campus Safety (location # 14 on the map) to be screened prior to admittance to the testing site. You must wear a mask.

- Arrive early to allow time for screening, parking, admittance.
- You will need to show your driver's license or other legal ID.

#### **Manikin Exam Information**

- All information provided on the Facility Information sheet applies to the ADEX Manikin Treatment Clinical Exam (MTCE).
- NHTI Facility fee must be received **by noon on September 29, 2020**. Only credit card payments will be accepted. Credit card payments cannot be processed on the day of the exam.
- Infection Control will be strictly adhered to and include:
  - Full clinic attire (scrubs, head covering, PPE including gloves, level 3 mask, safety glasses or loupes, face shield).
  - Please bring clinic shoes to wear only in the clinic.

- Utility gloves must be worn for disinfection and instrument handling.
- Sterile Instruments Needed – even though it is a manikin exam, instruments must be sterile to reduce any possible contamination to the manikins. Instruments must be in cassettes and/or containers for safe transport to and from, and within the clinic.
  
- All materials & equipment brought into the clinic must be latex-free.
  
- Mandatory Meeting with CDCA Examiners – all candidates must attend the Q & A with CDCA Examiners on Thursday October 1, 2020 at 6:30 via Zoom. The Zoom invite will be sent to those registered. Please read your manuals beforehand, view this <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4-hkGhbD5tg> and bring your questions to the Q & A session.
  
- Building Access – due to COVID-19, all buildings on campus are locked. You will be let into the building following screening by Campus Safety.
  
- Food/Beverages are not available on campus. There are fast foot establishments & grocery stores located within a mile of the campus. Food or drink is not allowed in any clinical areas.
