**Clinic equipment, instruments, & materials provided by the school:**

All operatories will have be equipped with a cavitron. We will have extra dental hygiene instruments and cavitron tips for emergencies.

Anesthesia: cotton swab, topical, lidocaine w/epi and mepivacaine, long and short needle, ProTector Needle Sheath

Barriers: barrier tape, tray with protective barrier, air/water/syringe sleeves

Patient Care: pre-procedural rinse, patient bibs, cups, 2 x 2 gauze, saliva ejector, disposable air/water tip, prophylaxis angle and paste, disclosing solution with dappen dish

**Candidate must supply material list:**

You will need to bring your own instruments in a cassette, ultrasonic tip(s) (30K) in a cassette, slow speed hand piece for polishing and a syringe for anesthesia.

All PPE (gown, mask, glasses, gloves, surgical cap and scrubs).  
Protective eye wear for the patient.

The Prairie State College Dental Hygiene Clinic is located in the Health Tech building on Vollmer Road in Chicago Heights, Ill.

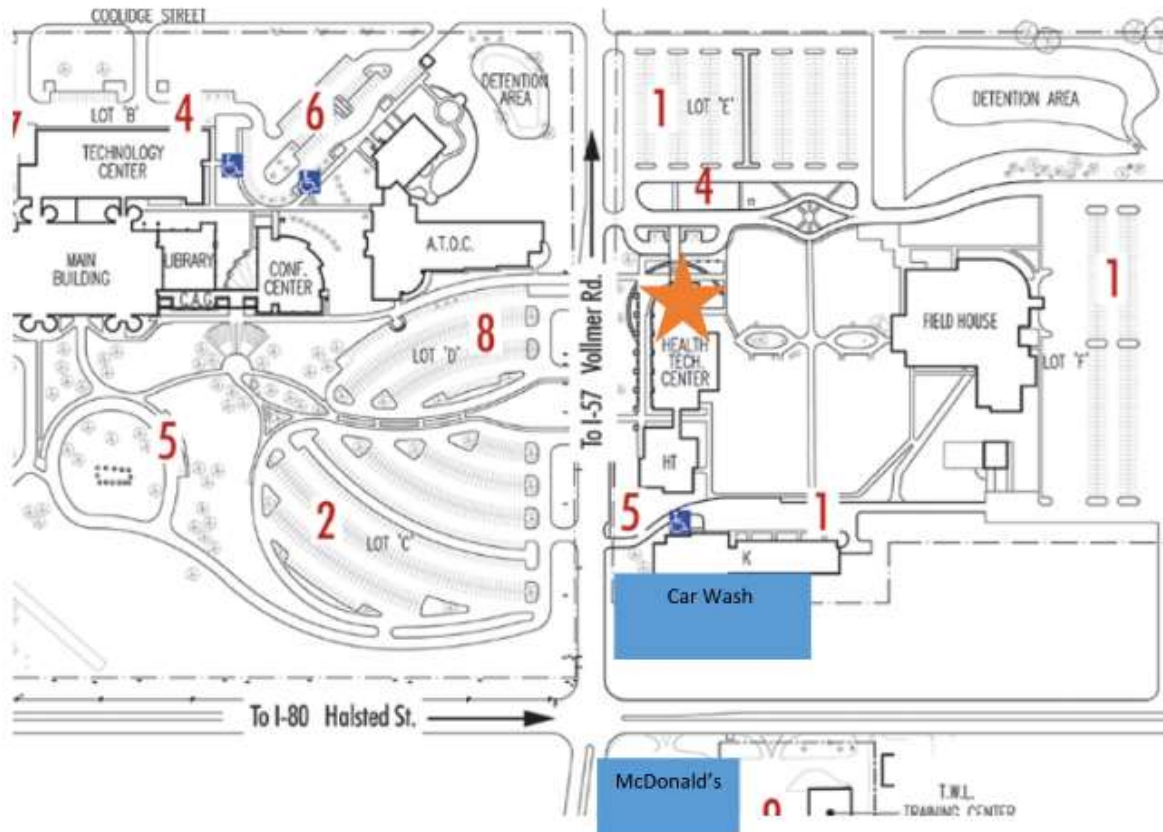
PSC is less than 30 miles from Chicago's downtown Loop, and is accessible by interstate highways and major roads.

From the north: Drive south on I-94 to I-80 west exit. Follow I-80 west about two miles to Halsted Street south exit (Route 1). Take Halsted Street south about three miles and turn left on Vollmer to the Health Tech building, which will be on your right.

From the north/west: Take the Tri-State Tollway (294) south to I-80/94 east. Follow I-80/94 east about one mile to Halsted Street south exit (Route 1). Take Halsted Street south about three miles and turn left on Vollmer to the Health Tech building, which will be on your right.

From the south: Drive north on I-57 to the Vollmer Road exit. Follow Vollmer Road east about five miles to the PSC campus on your left.

From the east: Follow I-80 west to Halsted Street south exit (Route 1). Take Halsted Street south about three miles and turn left on Vollmer to the Health Tech building, which will be on your right.
